PROSECCO SPUMANTE, LUNETTA NV TRENINO, N ITALY

-

A deliciously light and fruity Prosecco with hints of apple and peach on the nose and a fresh softly sparkling palate.

PINOT GRIGIO, BRUME DI MONTE LOMBARDY, N.W. ITALY

-

Lombardy is lesser known for its wine and more for its dense population and wealth centered around Milan. However, great quality wine can easily be found. This Pinot Grigio has vibrant, crisp green fruit with light undertones of almond on the finish.

WINE MENU

WHITE: ORIGIN

CUVEE JEAN PAUL SEC GASCOGNY, S.W. FRANCE

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Made from quality grapes (Ugni Blanc, Colombard) selected from Vin de Pays des Cotes de Gascogne, this is a deliciously fresh wine with a fragrant nose, zesty flavours and invigorating finish. Characters of crisp green fruit on the palate and lively acidity, it is quite dry but exuberantly fruity with a very clean finish - making this an uncomplicated easy drinking dry white wine.

MACABEO, BODEGAS BORSAO CAMPO BE BORJA, SPAIN

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Fresh, lightly savoury nose of ripe peach, lemon and fennel. Peach and cashew nut characters are matched by a broad textural palate and a clean fruity finish with citrus undertones.

SAUVIGNON BLANC, LOS TRES CURAS CENTRAL VALLEY, CHILE

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The Central Valley in Chile is a great source of ripe, healthy fruit ideal for wine production. The Mediterranean climate tempered by cooling Pacific breezes aids the production of highly aromatic whites such as this Sauvignon Blanc. Aromas of citrus fruits, green apple and pineapple with a steely mineral edge.

'ARUM FIELDS' CHENIN BLANC, DARLING CELLARS WESTERN CAPE, SOUTH AFRICA

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Packed with up front tropical fruit, the nose charms with an abundance of guava and goosberries. The palate follows through with delightful fruit flavours, balanced by crisp acidity to ensure a fresh and fruity style of wine.

PINOT GRIGIO, BRUME DI MONTE LOMBARDY, N.W. ITALY

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BIG RIVERS CHARDONNAY, MURPHY'S VINEYARDS MURRAY RIVER, AUSTRALIA

-

Fresh and fruit driven on the nose with ripe citrus and subtle tropical aromas, mineral notes and a hint of honey. Crisp and well balanced with a ripe fruit palate, a leesy texture and a lingering, fruity finish.

WHITE

**RIOJA BLANCO, BODEGAS LUIS ALEGRE RIOJA,
N. SPAIN**

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An unoaked white Rioja which works brilliantly as an aperitif or with lighter dishes. Aromas of peach and pineapple are complimented by refreshing notes of pink grapefruit. The palate is pleasantly light making this a very easy-drinking style. easy drinking dry white wine.

**GAVI, CONCHETTA, LA BATTISTINA PIEMONTE,
N.W. ITALY**

-
A gently aromatic, dry white with ripe pear, lime and herbaceous characters typical of the Cortese grape variety. Lightly textured on the palate with a long finish.

**CELLAR SELECTION SAUVIGNON BLANC, SILENI ESTATE
MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND**

-
Classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, with it's aromatic nose of fragrant lime, freshly cut grass and ripe passionfruit. The palate is balanced, generous and intense with notes of gooseberry, fennel and juniper. The wine has excellent concentration and persistence.

**ORBALLO ALBARINO, BODEGAS LA VAL GALICIA,
N.W. SPAIN**

-
A great example of this fashionable variety from North-West Spain. Typical of Albarino it shows ripe aromatics with layers of mandarin and apple with delicate floral and honeyed notes. Lively acidity with a long mineral finish.

**POUILLY FUME 'LE FUSIL DE CHASSE', JEAN JACQUES
BRETON LOIRE VALLEY, FRANCE**

-
Benchmark Pouilly-Fumé showing great regional and varietal character. Pouilly Fumé is Sancerre's Loire Valley neighbour, produced from Sauvignon Blanc. As the name suggests it is often characterised by a faintly smoky aroma which very much complements the zesty, gooseberry aromas in the wine.

CHABLIS, DOMAINE DES MALANDES BURGUNDY, FRANCE

-
A delicate Chablis, fermented in stainless steel tanks and aged in stainless steel for 6 to 10 months. On the nose it has good minerality and aromas of of lemon and lime. This wine is open and well balanced. Great as an aperitif or with white meats and salads.

ROSE

CUVEE JEAN PAUL ROSE LANGUEDOC, FRANCE

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A vivid pale strawberry pink with aromas of crushed red berries and appealing soft berry flavours, dry yet fruity with some crunchy acidity on the finish, this is an easy drinking fresh rosé with real character.

RIOJA ROSADO, BODEGAS LUIS ALEGRE RIOJA, N. SPAIN

-

A Tempranillo rosé of the highest quality. Gently fruity on the nose with strawberry and cherry aromas. A very light touch of spice on the finish.

CUVEE JEAN PAUL ROUGE LANGUEDOC, FRANCE

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Ripe strawberry and blueberry fruit of the Grenache with a sprinkling of Syrah spice. So smooth, you don't need to think about it. Classic Rhone red, friendly, warming and ample.

GARNACHA, BODEGAS BORSALO CAMPO DE BORJA, SPAIN

-

It would be hard to find a more highly praised, recognised and awarded wine than this Garnacha! Full of juicy bramble and cherry fruit with layers of licquorice and black pepper. Soft and supple on the palate.

MERLOT, LOS TRES CURAS CENTRAL VALLEY, CHILE

-

Classic Chilean Merlot; heaps of ripe plum and raspberry fruit with a delicate leafy character. Soft and fruity on the palate with velvety smooth tannins.

PINOT NOIR, CALUSARI ROMANIA

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Romania has a history of winemaking stretching back millennia and it was this potential paired with highest quality vine stock from France that has earned Calusari its reputation. The Pinot Noir is soft and juicy with bags of ripe red fruits and hints of vanilla complimented by delicate gamey undertones.

BIG RIVERS SHIRAZ, MURPHYS VINEYARD MURRAY RIVER, AUSTRALIA

-

A fruity, smooth shiraz with blackberry and redcurrant flavours and a characteristic spicy finish.

RED

RIOJA TINTO, BODEGAS LUIS ALEGRE RIOJA, N.E. SPAIN

-
Fruity and fresh with soft smooth tannins. Really juicy and succulent red with blackberry to the fore.

RESERVE DE FLEUR, COTES DU RHONE RHONE VALLEY, FRANCE

-
A modern unoaked Cotes du Rhone, blended to reflect its origins in the hot southern Rhone Valley. Rich forest fruit aromas with classic undertones of wild herbs and peppery spice.

CH TERREFORT LESCALLES BORDEAUX, FRANCE

-
A well-run Chateau with a modern approach to wine-making. Their aim is to produce generous, approachable wines with a softer mouth-feel. Typical blackcurrant and damson on the nose with layers of tobacco and cedar.

MALBEC, ALTAS CUMBRES MENDOZA, ARGENTINA

-
This wine is smoky, with blackberry and licorice fruit that keeps a firm grip through the finish. It is rich and long with smoky accents of vanilla and lingering oak. Enjoy with pasta, red meats and white meats in light cream sauces.

THE DEN PINOTAGE, PAINTED WOLF WINES COASTAL REGION, SOUTH AFRICA

-
Pinotage has become the flagship variety of South Africa though few producers have managed to do it justice. However, through meticulous work in the vineyards, Painted Wolf have managed to reveal the grape's true potential. A stunning wine with red and black fruits, warm spice and toasty wood flavours.

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LAMOLE CHIANTI CLASSICO, I FABRI TUSCANY, ITALY

-
Typical Tuscan red with rich, dark cherry fruit and rustic, earthy undertones. I fabri strongly believe in sustainable agriculture with great respect for the environment and local eco-systems. Due to the level of care in the vineyard the wines have exceptional purity.

FLEURIE, VIEILLES VIGNES, POTEAU AVIRON BEAUJOLAIS, FRANCE

-
Fleurie is one of the ten 'Beaujolais Cru' villages. The grapes are from very old parcels of vines which means lower yields and richer flavours. Forget Beaujolais Nouveau, this is the real deal; complex and structured with blackberry and loganberry fruit and a heady perfume wild flowers and orris root.

SPARKLING WINE

CAVA BRUT RESERVE, PERELADA NV CATALUNYA, SPAIN

-
Pale yellow colour with a good bubble persistence. Due to its 15 months ageing it has developed a fine aroma with some fruit hints. Well balanced with elegant richness.

ROSE SPUMANTE, LUNETTA NV TRENINO, N ITALY

-
Pale cherry red, clean and bright. Generous streams of fine bubbles with delicate strawberry aromas and complex but fruity taste.

PROSECCO SPUMANTE, LUNETTA NV TRENINO, N ITALY

-
A deliciously light and fruity Prosecco with hints of apple and peach on the nose and a fresh softly sparkling palate.

CHAMPAGNE

FORGET BRIMONT, PREMIER CRU, NV CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE

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This small Growers champagne offers wonderful value for money. Based in their town of Craon de Ludes Michel Forget owns 9 hectares of prime Pinot Noir Vineyards planted mainly in Grand Cru' sites. This is a Pinot dominated blend with a small percentage of Chardonnay. It is wonderfully expressive with a subtle yet lingering palate.

JOSEPH PERRIER, CUVÉE ROYALE, BRUT NV CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE

-
Traditional assemblage of grapes (35% Chardonnay, 65% Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier). Pale golden colour with fine mousse. Fresh with a full round body, which comes from a minimum of 3 years ageing in cellars. This well balanced cuvee is the epitome of 'Joseph's' style.

GUSBOURNE BRUT 2009, GUSBOURNE ESTATE, KENT, ENGLAND

-
Made from the classic Champagne grapes of Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier & Chardonnay. Zesty and fresh with a good citrus structure and lemon influences. Baked apples, pears nuts and oatmeal on the palate make this a superb alternative to Champagne. Voted 'Best English wine producer' at the International Wine & Spirits Challenge 2013

JOSEPH PERRIER, VINTAGE 2002 CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE

-
Made up of equal parts of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir from an exceptional year. This cuvee ages for a minimum of 5 years prior to release. Supple and graceful giving a floral bouquet with a full rich style.

POL ROGER, WHITE FOIL, NV CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE

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On the nose the Champagne is dominated by white flowers, green apple, brioche and a trace of minerality. On the palate there are notes of stone fruits, a certain nuttiness and a hint of honey supporting the freshness of the acidity.

ROSE CHAMPAGNE

**JOSEPH PERRIER, CUVEE ROYALE, ROSE BRUT NV
CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE**

Inviting scents of raspberries, blackberries and blackcurrants, with a delicate and smooth bouquet. On the palate, sensuous hints of red berries with a fresh and drawn out finish.

**FORGET BRIMONT, PREMIER CRU, ROSE NV CHAMPAGNE,
FRANCE**

Pale salmon pink in colour with attractive, delicate red summer fruit characteristics.

SWEET WINE

**MOSCATO PASSITO, IL CASCINONE 37.5CL PIEMONTE,
N.W.ITALY**

A deliciously well balanced sticky with honeyed, floral aromas. Ripe apricot and acacia honey characters on the palate with a core of homemade lemon curd running through to the long, fresh and lingering finish.

**LATE HARVEST SEMILLON/GEWURZTRAMINER,
CASA SILVA 37.5CL COLCHAGUA VALLEY, CHILE**

This lively wine offers floral aromas mixed with notes of pink grapefruit and orange confiture. On the palate it is round, full bodied, with good acidity and notes of orange peel.

RED SWEET WINE

**RECIOTO DELLA VALPOLICELLA, CANTINE DE NEGRAR
50CL VENETO, N.E.ITALY**

Deep ruby red in colour with a lovely perfume of dried cherries with a characteristic bitter twist. On the palate it is sweet and luscious, with a rounded, rich dried cherry character. Despite its sweetness, it is not cloying and has an attractive clean finish.
